Shelldale Family Gateway has had an incredibly successful and special relationship with Skyline since the early 2000's. Significant and positive changes have been made over the past 25 years, and it is due in large part to the efforts of the incredible staff and their ongoing support to make an incredible difference.

Many of our families live in various Skyline buildings situated close to the Shelldale Centre. Skyline's dedication to help families live in a healthy

supportive community is important and they give back to the community in so many ways. They provide financial resources to support our programming; they participate in many of our fundraisers to demonstrate their commitment to the community. They have provided guidance to the infrastructure of the organization and have volunteered in many special events. Over the past three years, Skyline has supported 280 young people through its active involvement in the "Patriots of the Arts" initiative, which it proudly funds. 

